The main objective is to strengthen participants' skills in EU project drafting, increasing their chances of successfully securing EU funding. The training will therefore focus on practical tips and tricks for writing the different sections of a proposal, rather than on a general explanation of the structure or characteristics of EU programmes. Teaching methods will combine interactive lectures with group-work sessions, in which participants will work on and discuss real project-drafting cases.
